From a merchant's point of view, I would go for SMART. The way SMART designed their system is specifically addressed to my customer's ease and advantage. With their method of depositing cash to the system and the SMART Money Card availability, it is a b factor for me as a merchant to let my customers use a very easy system. Below is a table I made based on my experience and furthe study on both the service providers.






Step 2: After the online shopping, check out my cart (with my account on metrodeal log in) and choose to pay the said purchase over Globe Gcash






Step 4: I receive a text from Dragon requesting a collection from my Globe Gcash.




Step 5: I have replied with my MPIN to verify the said transaction
